

Day 5 - Renewal in our Region


• Pray for all who don't know Jesus - that they would encounter God's presence and experience God's kindness, compassion and grace that leads to repentance and transformation.

Day 5 - Community Groups


• Pray for discipleship and community to be championed in these spaces

Praying for a Move of God

Jan 22-28

For the final week of our 21 days of prayer, we are praying for our move of God in and through our church community.

God graciously invites us to be part of what is at work in the world. As you begin this year remember the words and stories of scripture. Those unqualified, uncertain and unprepared were invited to take a step of faith in following the call of God. It was the graciousness of God demonstrated over and over again - not by our strength but by His. Come, Holy Spirit - move in our hearts. move in our city.

Day 1 - Humility and Hope

• Pray that we would be a people surrendering our lives daily. Pray that discouragement and disappointment wouldn't get the final word but hope would rise in our church.

Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience - Colossians 3:12

Day 2 - Reconciliation and Restoration

• Pray for specific areas of brokenness in your own life. We believe that reconciliation and restoration is the heart of the Father. May it happen in our lives.

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. - Romans 5:10

Day 3 - Healing and Deliverance

• Pray for wounds that have been dealt, for wounds that remain, and for darkness to be overcome. No weapon formed those who declare the name of Jesus shall prosper.

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. - 1 Peter 2:24

Day 4 - Lives Marked by the Fruit of the Spirit

• Pray for the Spirit of God that lives within His children to be known by the words and actions of our lives. May all that we desire for our world first begin in us.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. - Galatians 5:22-23

Day 5 - Spiritual Gifts Identified and Exercised

• Pray for all in our community to discover the gifts of the Spirit that exist within each of them. Pray that they might live with boldness and freedom to exercise the gifts of the spirit with wisdom, discernment, and Christ-centred focus.

Day 6 - Wisdom and Discernment by the Spirit


